BASKETBALL PRACTICES BEGIN ON OCTOBER 30th

Basketball practices will begin on Monday, October 30th. The teams will practice at the following times the first week of practice:

ATHLETIC STUDY HALLS

Extra study times will be assigned to athletes who have grades below 60%. Each athlete is to be logging extra study time with their coach each week. TEAMS COMPETE IN DISTRICT ACTION

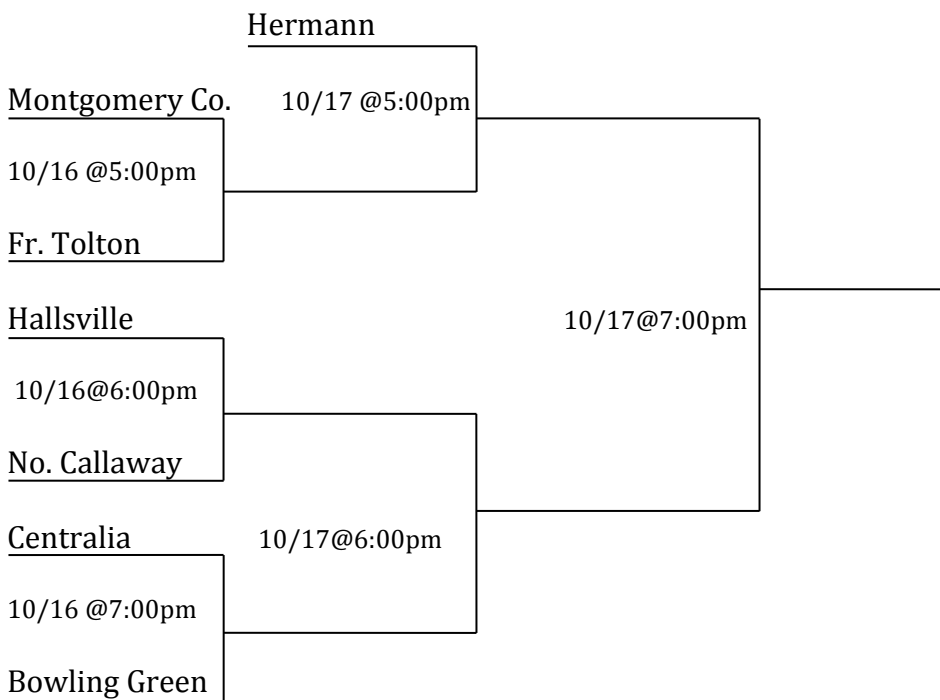

The softball team completed their season in the district tournament at Linn on October 5. The softball awards night will be held Monday, October 23rd at 5:30 PM in the high school library.

The football team will open district play on October 21. We will find out our week ten opponent and the location of our first round district game after week nine's games are complete.

Hermann will host this year's district volleyball tournament. District play will begin on Monday, October 16 with first round games. Winners of the first round games advance to Tuesday where there will be semifinal games followed by the championship game. The winner of our district will travel to the winner of District 8 on Saturday, October 21. The District bracket is shown below.

The varsity cross country team will compete in the District Cross Country Meet at Linn on Saturday, October 28. The state cross country meet is set for Saturday, November 4 at Oak Hills Golf Center in Jefferson City.
